**Policies & Procedures:**

Peggy reports that the bank account now maintains a balance of \$100. She hasn't heard from the State regarding the unclaimed funds of ~\$600 from an old bank account. The State received paperwork on 7/8/14 and can take up to 180 days to process.

- Bill Foster voiced concerns about the church hosting The Gathering Inn and attendees not following protocol. He understood that attendees are only supposed to be staying for the evening not overnight and are supposed to check in at The Gathering Inn prior to coming to the church. He noticed people waiting at the church and sleeping in cars. Darby said he'd look into it and find out what's going on.
- Darby asked if NNO had any lasting effects on the neighborhood. Peggy mentioned that she got together with some of her neighbors for a BBQ and discussed starting back up a Neighborhood Watch.
- Hillcrests' Quarterly Community Meeting is coming up on Nov 12<sup>th</sup> and there was some discussion about possible topics & guest speakers. Bill is still trying to get in touch with the person RCONA recommended to speak regarding Identity Protection. Andrea emailed Officer David Flood to see if he'd be willing to come out and speak at one of our meetings regarding the local transient population. Andrea suggested someone coming out from Green Acres to discuss winterizing our yards. Bill

informed us that all communication with Roseville PD is supposed to go through Sgt. Josh Simon at [jsimon@roseville.ca.us](mailto:jsimon@roseville.ca.us). Andrea will email him to let him know about our monthly and community meetings and request that our neighborhood officer attend (if possible). Lisa needs to have all the info that's going into this quarters' newsletter no later than 10/20. She'll have them printed and Peggy will drop off to be delivered at least a week in advance of the community meeting. We still need an advertiser to sponsor printing, which cost ~\$140. Steve offered to have his company – Armoured Plumbing if need be. There was also some discussion about delivering to St. Catherine Arms apartments and Steve mentioned that he knows the manager and suggested delivering the newsletters to her. We also brainstormed about some topics for upcoming newsletters and how to entice more attendance at community meetings:
